DJP HANDWASHING GUIDELINES

Hand washing is the single most important line of defense in preventing the transmission of disease- causing organisms.

When should hands be washed:

	Immediately before handling food, preparing bottles or feeding children	
	After handling food	
	Before handling clean utensils or equipment	
	After using the bathroom.	
	After assisting a child in using the toilet, or changing diapers	
	After handling bodily fluids 9e.g., saliva, nasal secretions, vomit, feces, urine, blood,	
	secretions from sores, puss discharges).	
	After handling soiled items such as garbage, mops, cloths, and clothing	
	Whenever hands are visibly soiled.	
	After removing disposable gloves.	
CHILDREN		
	Children shall wash hands upon arrival at DJP	
	After each diaper change or visit to the toilet	
	Immediately before eating meals or snacks	
	After eating meals or snacks	
	Before and after water or sensory activities	
	After playing on the playground after handling animals or animal cages	
	Whenever hands are visibly soiled
