All that being said;

Thank G-d, we were notified that we have been approved for the PPP loan. This is a tremendous relief for all of us! For now, we are offering each family an equal rebate in the tuition.

10% percent off your total tuition (after registration and security) per child.

This rebate is regardless of your payment plan. Some of you have 1 payment out of 10 left, so your last payment would be your 10% and will NOT be charged. Some of you have 2 payments left out of 10 and therefore 1 of those payments would be your 10% and you can chose which month you prefer.

Some of you have 0 payments left and upon your request, will be reimbursed 10%.

The PPP loan is to help us get by over the next 6 weeks. It does NOT cover all our expenses, nor all our salaries and we would be grateful for anyone who would like to donate their 10% back to the school. Changes and reductions to tuition will remain regardless if we go back to school physically or remain at home with virtual learning.
