



## The Marc & Miriam Anidjar Hebrew for Kids OUTLINE FOR VIRTUAL LEARNING



To accommodate for all the families in our community, we have worked our schedule to allow for virtual class participation.

The following is the schedule.

Virtual classes will take place:

Sundays from 11:00am -1:00pm

11:00am-12:00pm Judaic Curriculum & Crafts

12:00pm -1:00pm Prayers & Hebrew Reading Aleph Champ

### **11:00am-12:00pm Judaic Curriculum & Crafts**

Your child will join their respective class at Hebrew for Kids at 11:00am via a ZOOM code supplied to you.

The teacher in School at Hebrew for Kids will acknowledge the ZOOM children and welcome them to class.

Packets will be available for pick up on Thursdays.

The packets will include the same supplies and crafts that the children in LIVE school will be receiving on Sunday so they can partake and learn together.

They will be encouraged to participate via ZOOM together with their friends and teachers at school.

The class will be approximately 45-50 minutes

It will end at 11:50 to allow for clean-up and goodbyes.

(The LIVE classroom will be doing the same: clean up and dismissal)

Your children will log off and have 10-15 minute break before we resume with the second hour of Hebrew School.

### **12:00-1:00pm Prayers & Hebrew Reading Aleph Champ**

At 12:00pm your child will log in to a different ZOOM number supplied to you.

This hour will cover Prayers and Hebrew Reading.

The Hebrew reading ZOOM groups will be divided by Aleph Champ level colors.

They will commence with Prayers and then Hebrew reading.

Considering these private ZOOM classes will be small, we anticipate that the children on ZOOM will be able to get more attention for their Hebrew reading.

The second class will end approximately 12:45 with clean-up and goodbyes.
