PARENT TEACHER CLASS ORIENTATIONS

Due the new COVID guidelines we will not have all the parents together in the school building; therefore, we have created staggered in school orientation. Please note:

- For safety, the appointments are staggered 2 families at a time only.
- Both parents and or guardian are welcome to join. (2 adults only)
- Parents are required to wear masks indoors.
- Proof of negative PCR test for your child must be submitted prior to your scheduled appointment.
- A lice check will take place in the social hall before entering the classroom. Arrive 5 minutes early to allow for lice check time.
- The appointment times are 10 minutes.

NEW STUDENTS ONLY

Tuesday, August 24 through Friday, August 27 is what we call '**PHASE IN**' days for the children who have not attended DJP. You will drop your child off at the scheduled time of 9:00am and remain in the proximity of the school. The first day of school your child will remain for 1 hour only. Each day we increase the amount of time that your child is in the class without you. In the event that your child may need some extra comforting in his new setting, you will be available to pick them up. These '**phase in**' days enable a smooth and happy transition.
